RESOLUTION REGARDING SECURITY SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of Franklin Township Fire District 3, (hereafter Fire District) has installed a video/audio taping system in the Fire District's office solely as a security measure, to monitor the offices in case of a security breach; and

WHEREAS, the offices of the Fire District is a public place, and the existence of said audio/video taping system is a matter of public knowledge throughout the Fire District; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the said offices of the Fire District are a public place, and notwithstanding that Fire District employees, Fire Commissioners, and members of the Fire District utilize said offices with knowledge that an audio/video security monitoring system is recording activities and conversations, the Fire Commissioners nevertheless believe that Fire District members, and particularly Fire District employees, have an expectation of privacy with respect to certain conversations of a personal nature not prohibited by the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF FIRE DISTRICT NO. 3 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, on this 15th day of December, 2010 that the Board of Fire Commissioners hereby adopts a policy as follows:


1. No person, including Fire Commissioners, shall view any part of the audio/video security system except upon authority of a majority vote of the Board of Fire Commissioners;
2. Any such authority given by a majority of the Board of Fire Commissioners to any person(s) to view any part of said audio/video security monitoring system, shall be strictly construed; and
3. These restrictions announced in this policy shall not be applicable to Federal, State, or Local law enforcement agencies or agents acting in the furtherance of their duties as in such instances, authority by a majority

vote of the Board of Fire Commissioner to view any part of the audio/video security monitoring system shall be implied.

4. Any connection between the audio/video security monitoring system and the Internet shall be disconnected and not be connected again except upon majority vote of the Board of Fire Commissioners.
